

# 2021 IOM Coastal Cup Series

## Overview:

Due to Covid 19 isolation and travel restrictions, the 2020 Coastal Cup did not happen. Now that most of the restrictions have been lifted here in BC, we have planned for a shortened Coastal Cup Series. This year the Coastal Cup is a series of four (mainly one day) IOM regattas held in conjunction with some existing regattas on the West Coast of BC with one event per month from July to October. It is an informal series designed to give local IOM sailors an opportunity to compete amongst each other to hone their skills. There is a nominal entry fee of \$25 to participate in the series, which some sailors already paid last year, before Covid hit and cancelled the series. There are 4 different locations for this year's CC series, with one on the mainland (Steveston) and three being held in various locations around Vancouver Island. The \$25 entry fee includes participation in CC4 Pacific Regional Championship regatta. There is a \$20 entry fee for non-CC entries at this event. Tokens & prizes will be awarded at the last event CC4 at Saltspring Island Sailing Club

To allow for ferries, no races will start before 10:00am or end after 4:00pm.

## Details:

- CCs 1, 2, & 4 are open to any CRYA or AMYA-members in good standing
- There will be separate NORs, Sis & entry forms for the Woody & Regional Championship regattas.
- CC3 is being combined with a 2-day Woodie IOM regatta. The Woodies will be sailing with the CC3 entrants Sept. 11<sup>th</sup> and in their own fleet on Sept. 12<sup>th</sup>. Due to space limitations at the RVicYC dock CC3 will initially be open to only Woodie & CC participants (max. 2 heats). CC3 will open to other IOM sailors if room allows, one month before the regatta.
- The \$25 entry fee must be paid in full by CC2, to John Ball or Art Prufer (see entry form for details).
- Only participants that have paid the entry fee will be actually scored in the CC series
- For the purpose of scoring the final results at the end of the series, non-participants will be removed from each of the regatta results and 1 point will be awarded for first place, 2 for second, 3 for third. Lowest score of the series gets first place, etc. , missed regattas will result in a score of the number of paid attendees at the event +1
- There is 1 throw-out for the whole series
- The boat must have a current measurement certificate
- There will be no measuring done at any of the non-ranking CC events, but boats are expected to remain in compliance for the complete series.
- Waivers may be required for some events

CC1 - July 18	Imperial Landing, Steveston - SRCS
CC2 - August 14	Long Lake, Loudon Park, Nanaimo - WCRS
CC3 - September 11	RVYC, Oak Bay – RVYC/WCRS
CC4 - October 23,24	SISC Ganges, Saltspring Island – SISC/WCRS (Pacific Regional Championship Regatta)

Regatta details and signup forms for each event should be provided one month in advance of each regatta. Notifications and signup forms will be posted on the [WCRS web site](#) and [Forum](#), and the [FB Pacific Region RC Sailing group](#) as well as by email for those that have entered the CC using this entry form - .

This is meant to be a friendly competition open to all IOM sailors.

Please respect the organizers and volunteers running the events as well as the other competitors that are there to test their skills against other skippers and boats.
