September 11/12, 2021**



Notice of Race

The Royal Victoria Yacht Club invites sailors with wooden hull boats that meet the rules of the IOM class, and have a IOM certificate, to the 2021 Canadian IOM Woodie National Championship. This regatta is organized under the delegated national authority of the Canadian Radio Yachting Association (CRYA) and conducted by the Royal Victoria Yacht Club as the organizing authority and its duly appointed Race Committee.

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (The RRS) as modified by Appendix E, the Prescriptions of Sail Canada, the Equipment Rules of Sailing, the IOM class rules and the Heat Management System. Woodies will race with non-woodies on Saturday Sept 11 as part of Coastal Cup #3. For the purposes of the WNCR, scores for woodies will be extracted by giving the top scoring woodie in each race a 1st, the next woodie a 2nd, etc, until all woodies are scored separately. Those scores will carry over to Sunday Sept 12, where woodies only will continue to race

All racing and social activities will be held under provincial health guidelines as published by BC Sailing as well as related protocols of the Royal Victoria Yacht Club at the time of the event. Competitors agree to adhere to these guidelines and protocols.

2. Eligibility:

Entrants must be current members of the CRYA, or their National Authority. Yachts must be legally certificated IOM class boats but with the hull made primarily out of wood. Class-legal non-wood material is allowable for keel trunk, servo mounts, internal structure and deck. Proof of membership and certificate must be presented upon registration.

Competitors with a disability who require any form of help or special requirements should, prior to entry, get in touch with the club contact to confirm that suitable arrangements can be made. The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are suitable and, if necessary, provide a suitable support person

3. Schedule

Event Check in and measurement/inspection will be available on Friday evening Sept 10, and for out-of-town competitors on Saturday morning Sept 11. Racing on Sat Sept 11 will be in conjunction with Coastal Cup series #3, and woodie boats will share the race-course with non-woodies. All boats racing on Saturday will be scored for Coastal Cup #3. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 11:30 am, or earlier if all registered competitors are present and ready. No races will start after 5:00 pm. Woodies will participate in a show-and-shine event in the clubhouse on Saturday evening. Racing on Sunday 12 will be for woodies only, with the warning signal for the first race at 10:30, or earlier if all registered competitors are present and ready, and no races starting after 3:30 pm. There is no maximum number of races, however a minimum of [6] races must be completed to constitute this event.

4. Entry and Fees

Entry fee is \$15 for registered/payed Coastal Cup competitors, and \$40 for those who aren't registered/payed for Coastal Cup. This includes bbq lunch on both days. A no-host dinner will be available at the yacht club on Saturday evening. Please pay by e-transfer to Steve Kibble stevekibble@gmail.com.

Priority entry is open for currently-registered competitors of the Coastal Cup series until noon on July 24. After that, any entry will be open for any eligible boat. Entries must be received no later than Sept 4. Late entries after Sept 4 **may** be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Chairman. Late Entry fee will be \$25/50. Entries may be capped at 20 boats on a first come basis.

Sail number conflicts will be resolved based on the date of receipt of **paid** entries including those accepted after the entry deadline. This overrides Personal Sail Numbers.
